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Question 4: yearly cap on professional CEs?

No. Section 2.2.9 already takes care of this in the one year carryforward. I know general business and education courses are capped, but I can see that some people might benefit from a lot of professionalism.

Question 5: Sould the QS be expanded to cover all actuarial services?

No the Code of Professional CONduct covers other actuarial services well enough.

Various other Questions:

Mark Rowley, chairman of the smaller ins. co. section, has submitted thoughtful comments. I generally agrfee with them. Of note, he calls for having the ABCD (or some other group) being able to review and provide a statement on whether an actuary is responsible in a particular area.

On whether an actuary is qualified to sign an NAIC llife aa A&H annual statement if he / she is a bit light on health, I think the currenn Section 2.2.5 and 2.2.6 handle this (plus of course actuarial judgment).
